## **Membership Categories**

### **Full Beekeeping membership**

Full Beekeeping Member, minimum age 18 years, with the right to vote at General Meetings and Registered Member of British Beekeepers Association. Includes BDI (see below) for three colonies, BeeCraft and newsletters.

### **Partner Membership**

Partner Member, an individual beekeeper, minimum age 18 years, resident at the same address as a Full Beekeeping Member, Partner Member of the BBKA sharing one copy of communications sent to that address and no right to vote at General Meetings. A Full Beekeeping Member may have any number of (separate, qualifying) Partner Members associated with his/her membership at the same address.

### **Junior membership**

Junior Beekeeping Member, age between 10 and 18 years, with no right to vote at General Meetings and only handles bees under the supervision of their parent or guardian who is a Full Beekeeping Member. No affiliation to British Beekeepers Association and no copy of BeeCraft. Not eligible to attend classes or become adopt-a-hive student.

### **Associate membership**

Associate Member, does not keep bees with no right to vote at General Meetings, no affiliation to the British Beekeepers Association. Receives BeeCraft and newsletters.

## **Bee Diseases Insurance (BDI)**

BDI covers the insured for the statutory destruction of bees, honey and equipment for only American or European Foulbrood. For BDI to be valid all colonies owned by the beekeeper must be insured with BDI. BDI is valid from the date of the treasurer's receipt, but BDI paid after 31 March comes into force only 40 days after the date of the treasurer's receipt. Full details on the BDI certificate of insurance. Full Beekeeping Members and Partner Members are automatically insured for BDI for 3 colonies each. To calculate the total colonies for extra BDI subtract 3 colonies for each Partner Member.

## **Data Protection**

The information about you held by North London Beekeepers (NLB) has been stored on paper and computer records. This will be used by the NLB solely for purposes directly relating to its activities and, as a non-profit making organisation the NLB is therefore exempt from having to notify the Information Commissioner or to appear on a public register. The information will, where appropriate, be shared with the BBKA (on their secure register), Bee Disease Insurance (BDI) and BeeCraft for purposes of membership records, arranging insurance and managing subscriptions, respectively, and may be passed on to the National Bee Unit (a section of DEFRA) should it be requested for bee disease inspections.

The NLB will not pass on or sell information to any other body unless legally obliged to do so.
